## PRELUDE

Lala Rural College, (a Provincialised College accredited by the NAAC), was established in 1964 in a rural surroundings. It is situated in Lala, a small town of Hailakandi district in the southernmost part of Assam. The College is affiliated to Assam University (a Central University) has been offering both Arts & Commerce courses at Higher Secondary and Degree level.

The College is catering to the needs of a large number of people belonging to tea tribe, Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes and others.

During the initial days, classes used to be held in the premises of Lala H.S. & M.P. School, but soon the College authority with the help of the generous public donation of the locality and the members of the staff, shifted the classes to its own building situated in the bank of river Dhaleswari. The College has now eleven buildings including a Conference Hall (donated), a spacious Library and Auditorium. Arrangement for Arts and Commerce Classes has been done in two separate blocks.

Construction of a two story Women's Hostel under UGC Xith Plan has been completed and female students of disadvantaged sections may seek accommodation to the hostel.

Since its inception the College was affiliated to the Gauhati University. It has achieved a spectacular growth since 1975 when the Govt. of Assam brought it under Deficit Grants-in-Aid system. Lala Rural College is now in the prestigious band of permanently affiliated colleges under Assam University. The College has been provincialised by the Govt. of Assam in the year 2005.

### ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Admission to the H.S. courses starts after the announcement of H.S.L.C. examination result and to T.D.C. courses after the announcement of H.S. examination result. Admission schedule is announced in accordance with the AHSEC / AU notifications.

The candidates securing not less than 40% marks in the last examination shall be considered eligible for admission to HS. first year and TDC first semester.

Seat capacity (B.A. General: 300 & B.Com. General: 100).

All admissions are online mode. Students seeking admission to HS. 1st year are advised to go to the website of the college [www.lrcollege.org](http://www.lrcollege.org) After online submission of forms along with required documents, the name of selected candidates will be displayed in the website of the college as well as in the Notice Board. Selected students will have to produce original documents at the time of admission. All admissions are provisional and subject to the approval of the AHSE.

### ATTENDANCE RULES

As per CBCS Course structure distribution of marks for class attendance is-

Attendance 90% and above : 10 marks

Attendance 80% to below 90% : 8 marks

Attendance 75% to below 80% : 6 marks

Attendance below 75% : No marks as well as disqualification for appearing examination in the subject concerned.

### PATTERN OF UNIT TESTS

Unit Tests are compulsory for all classes of both H.S. & TDC. For H.S. classes (Arts & Commerce) it will be conducted in accordance with the lesson plan. In T.D.C. classes Unit Tests are compulsory for both Arts & Commerce stream and to be held as per the following calendar: -

**Odd Semester :** 1st Unit Test : In the month of September.

2nd Unit Test : In the month of October.

**Even Semester:** 1st Unit Test : In the month of March.

2nd Unit Test : In the month of April.

Each Test will be of 20 marks (each subject). Marks obtained in attendance and Unit Test will be part of Internal Assessment marks of 30 (Attendance 10 and Unit Test 20 marks)

## SCHOLARSHIP

1. National Merit Scholarship (on all India basis).
2. Merit cum means Scholarship.
3. State Merit Scholarship.
4. State O.B.C./ M.O.B.C./ Ex-tea Garden labourer Scholarship.
5. Lower Income Group Scholarship.

The eligible candidates may apply for scholarship with prescribed procedure and the same will be forwarded to the respective authorities for consideration and grants. However, it must be borne in mind that scholarship, free studentship or any other kind of assistance are granted to students invariably subject to the following three conditions:

- i. Satisfactory progress in studies.
- ii. Good conduct in the college and outside.
- iii. Regular attendance in the classes.

## N.S.S., EXTENSION ACTIVITIES AND N.C.C.

The College provides opportunities for joining N.S.S. and Extension Activities. The College with the help and co-operation of N.S.S. unit has adopted a village named *Rabidas Para*, W.No-1 & 2 of Lala Town and both teachers and students are taking an active part in educational and awareness activities in the said village. In addition, an LP School of that area named Rabidas Para L. P. School is also adopted by the college.



The College often organizes Special Camp for Health Awareness, Health Care, Blood Donation as well as Lockdown relief by providing essential food and COVID-19 safety materials etc. to the needy people.



Efforts are on to start NCC Programme. N.C.C. Officials have paid several visits to augment the process of opening N.C.C. wing at the college. This will be a singular achievement as it will provide impetus to students opting career in defence services. It may undertake training programmes in different localities, encouraging students for any eventualities.



## EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Games & sports, cultural activities, debate, literary exercises, symposia, seminars etc. are regularly arranged in the college in both physical and virtual platform under the supervision of experienced Professor-in-charges.



## WOMEN'S HOSTEL

To facilitate accommodation to outstation girls, there is a Women's Hostel which is constructed under UGC grants during the XIth Plan period. It can accommodate 20 students. In 2020, the Hostel was converted into a Quarantine Centre by the District Administration and is till under their occupancy.



## LIBRARY

Being the heart of academic pursuit, the college provides a spacious, accommodative and resourceful library with nearly thirteen thousand books. It also subscribes to some important dailies (both national and regional), periodicals and journals. The collage has taken initiatives to modernize the Library and as a part of the ongoing projects, the process of computerization has been undertaken.



It provides reading and lending services, reference service and photocopying. It also maintains a well ventilated reading room for both students and teachers.

There is a Book Bank in Library for the benefit of the students belonging to the BPL category. It provides an opportunity for lending book(s) for the whole session on certain conditions.



**DEPARTMENTAL LIBRARY**

Each Department has a separate library with text books and references from which students can derive benefit. Departments also bring out Departmental Journals. The Research & Publication Cell of the College publishes scholarly articles through its journal called 'Endeavour'.

**STUDENTS' UNION**

The Students' Union of the college is known as Lala **RuralCollege Students' Union**. The office bearers of the Students' Union are elected directly by the regular students' of the College. The main function of the students' Union is to look after the welfare of the students' and to conduct co-curricular activities, social works etc. With the amendment of the Union Constitution, the election will be held as per the recommendations of the Lyngdoh Commission as adopted in the Union Constitution. At present there is no acting body of Students' Union.

**THE COLLEGE MAGAZINE**

The College Magazine "ADHUNATON" is published annually. It provides the students a medium to give expression to their literary and intellectual endeavours.

**GENERAL RULES**

- # Application for change of subject(s) required to be made to the Principal through the respective HOD(S) within one month from the date of admission. Application received thereafter will not be accepted.
- # All kinds of college dues are payable on or before the dates notified from time to time.
- # Student, who fails to deposit his / her dues within specified period, will be declared defaulter and his / her name shall be dropped from the College Rolls. Under such circumstances he or she will be re-enrolled on request at the discretion of the Principal on payment of re-admission fees along with other arrear dues.
- # Applications for College Certificate/ Transfer Certificate etc. duly countersigned by the guardians shall have to be submitted with a fee of Rs. 100/- only.
- # Notices desired to be pasted or circulated by the students or others any where in the college shall require prior approval of the Principal. All notices for students are displayed on the College Notice Board.
- # Use of mobile phones within the campus is strictly prohibited.
- # All powers for maintaining rules and regulations are vested with the Principal and his decision will be final in all such matters.

**SPECIAL FEATURES**

- # The college can legitimately boast for its Teaching Staff. Some of them have participated in National and International Seminars on invitation. Most of the faculty members have Ph.D. or M.Phil. Degree. Some have authored a number of books and contributed articles in research journals. Many teachers have undertaken Minor Research Project (MRP) from UGC. A good number of teachers have obtained Ph.D. from different Universities. Many teachers are also invited as Resource Persons.

- # Modern method of Teaching and Educational technology including Audio-visual equipments is used in the classrooms. Smart class rooms are an added feature.
- # Online Classes and communication via Whatsapp, Google Classroom, Google Meet and so on based on the convenience of the Teachers and Students.
- # Teacher-student relationship is exemplary.
- # Academic calendar is strictly followed in teaching-learning activities.
- # Distribution of lesson plan in the beginning of the session is mandatory for all the HOD's
- # There are special facilities for dropouts.
- # UGC sponsored remedial coaching has been started in the college for the benefit of students belonging to minority and SC/ST categories.
- # UGC sponsored coaching classes for Entry Level Services have also been introduced.
- # A **Sixteen-Station Gymnasium** has been installed in the College with Central Government assistance for the benefit of the students and the employees of the College.

### ANTI-RAGGING MEASURES

There is complete ban on **RAGGING** in any form inside or outside the campus as per the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. Any student found involved in such activity, shall be severely punished which could lead to expulsion from the college. The College has a self-financed Computer Centre which offers various vocational courses at reasonable fees. It also provides technical assistance to the students belonging to commerce stream in connection to their academic courses. Students may have access to internet also.

**DISTANCE EDUCATION PROGRAMME**

Opening of Centre for Distance and Open Learning affiliated to Assam University (A Central University) covering all programmes of both arts and commerce stream has been in process subject to the availability of according permission from the University.

**SPORTS AND GYMNASIUM**

The College encourages sports of all sorts including basket ball. A sixteen station Gymnasium is functioning to equip students and involve greater participation from students' community. Efforts are on to open a Health Care Centre in the Campus and to cover the students under Insurance Scheme.

**COLLEGE AUDITORIUM**

The College has a well furnished auditorium. All the programmes/ Meeting / Seminars are conducted inside the newly built auditorium that can accommodate nearly 550 people.

**COLLEGE UNIFORM**

College Uniform is compulsory within the campus for all students. The uniform prescribed for:

**Boys:** Grey trouser, white shirt and grey tie or grey pajama and white kurta.

**Girls:** Grey salwar, white kamiz and grey churni or grey saree with white blouse.
