Resolution No. 1

The Principal /c apprised the members present about the implementation of C.B.C.S. from the current academic year. It requires compulsory attendance of minimum 75% for which 10 marks have been given in addition 20% marks have been allotted for Unit Test. In a subject of 100 marks, 30% has been allotted for internal assessment which can play a vital role in securing better marks under CBCS. The Principal /c as well as other teaching faculty discussed to attract the C.B.C.S. pattern and requested the guardian/parents present to give due emphasis on class performance through regular attendance.

Resolution No. 2

The Principal /c apprised the house the existence of NSS Cell in the College that undertakes various social services like adoption of a school, annual camps, blood donation camps, different awareness programmes and to clean an environment clean. Mr. Ganjam Ananda Barik, Programme Officer, N.S.S. has detailed out various works/activities undertaken by the NSS unit of the College and the house requests the Parents/guardians to enrol their wards to the N.S.S. Unit of the College.

Resolution No. 3

The Principal /c apprised the members of the house that the College has a Computer Centre to train the students at nominal fee and urged upon the guardian/parents to enrol their wards to the Computer Course.

Resolution No. 4

The Principal /c informed the house that like the previous year, this year ~~the~~ Govt. at Higher Education, sanctioned an amount of Rs 1 (one) lakh. ^{Coordinator}

excursion with a guideline to visit Rajasthan. Like the previous year, the Teachers' Council in its meeting held on 16-11-2018 outlined the norms of participating in the proposed excursion to be selected only from amongst the students of final semester to which the parents/guardians agreed. Since such an excursion enriches a student from diverse fields, the teachers present requested the guardians to allow their wards to take part in such educational tour as it is being guided by two teachers, one lady and one gent.

Resolution No. 5

The Bicepial i/c apprised the parents/guardians that that the as per Govt. circular, three guardians (parents) are included in the Govt. Body. The term of a parent is so long his/her ward is a student of the College. As a member of G.B., parents can contribute immensely to the cause of the College. With the expiry of the term of the present parents' members, new parents are to be selected through Parents' Meeting to which a similar meeting would be convened sometime in March/April 2019. The Bicepial i/c requested the parents to be present in that meeting which will be notified in due course.

Resolution No. 6

The Bicepial i/c apprised the members that Govt. of Assam, Higher Education has exempted students from paying necessary fees subject to the production of Income Certificate to the effect that the annual income of the parent of the concerned candidate is not over Rs 1 (One) lakh. As such almost half of the students of the College are covered under the scheme. But this year, the DHB, Assam directed the College to upload four certificates of each student viz (1) photograph of ~~the~~ ^{planting} sapling (2) Income Certificate (3) Last Examination Certificate &

an undertaking. Such items were to be uploaded within October 2018. Since the College does not have proper infrastructure to upload such huge documents (nearly 2000) within a stipulated period, the College has to hire services from outside but cost nearly ₹.50,000 (fifty thousand) only. At this, the parents/guardians present voluntarily came forward to contribute an amount from those students whose fees had been waived. The Principal I/C informed that he would notify the rate of amount in due course.

Resolution No.7

The Principal I/C informed the house that formation of Students' Union/Council has become very important in order to extend various amenities of the College amongst the students. As such the existing members of Students' Council have gone in drafting the College Constitution keeping in mind the recommendation of Lyndoh Commission. In a General Meeting held on 27/09/2018, students unanimously/overwhelmingly agreed to the proposal of selecting Class Representatives and accordingly 12/10/2018 was fixed for selection of Class Representatives. But on that day, the matter could not be settled as some students locked the gate of the College. The guardians/parents were also informed of peaceful formation of Students' Body. However with the coming of Panchayat Election on 09/12/2018, the drafting of employees for Poll related works as well as counting and the Odd Semester Examinations commencing on and from 17/12/2018, the house unanimously resolved to defer the Students' Body formation related matter till the Examinations were over and requested ~~the~~ Principal I/C to ~~maintain~~ a peaceful atmosphere in and around the College.



Resolution No. 6


The Principal apprised the members that the Governing Body has the provision of selecting three members from Parents with one female members. The Parents discussed among themselves and finally the following three members' name has come out:



- (a) The team will carry ~~extra~~ winter ~~clothing~~ ~~clothes~~ and they will take maximum luggage to make the


excursion enjoyable.






The Binipal i/c also highlighted various issues and services that the college has been providing for students' benefit and requested the parents/guardians to make their wards avail those benefits.




- (a) Since only handful guardians/Parents attended, efforts be taken from the side of parents to bring more parents in the next meeting.
