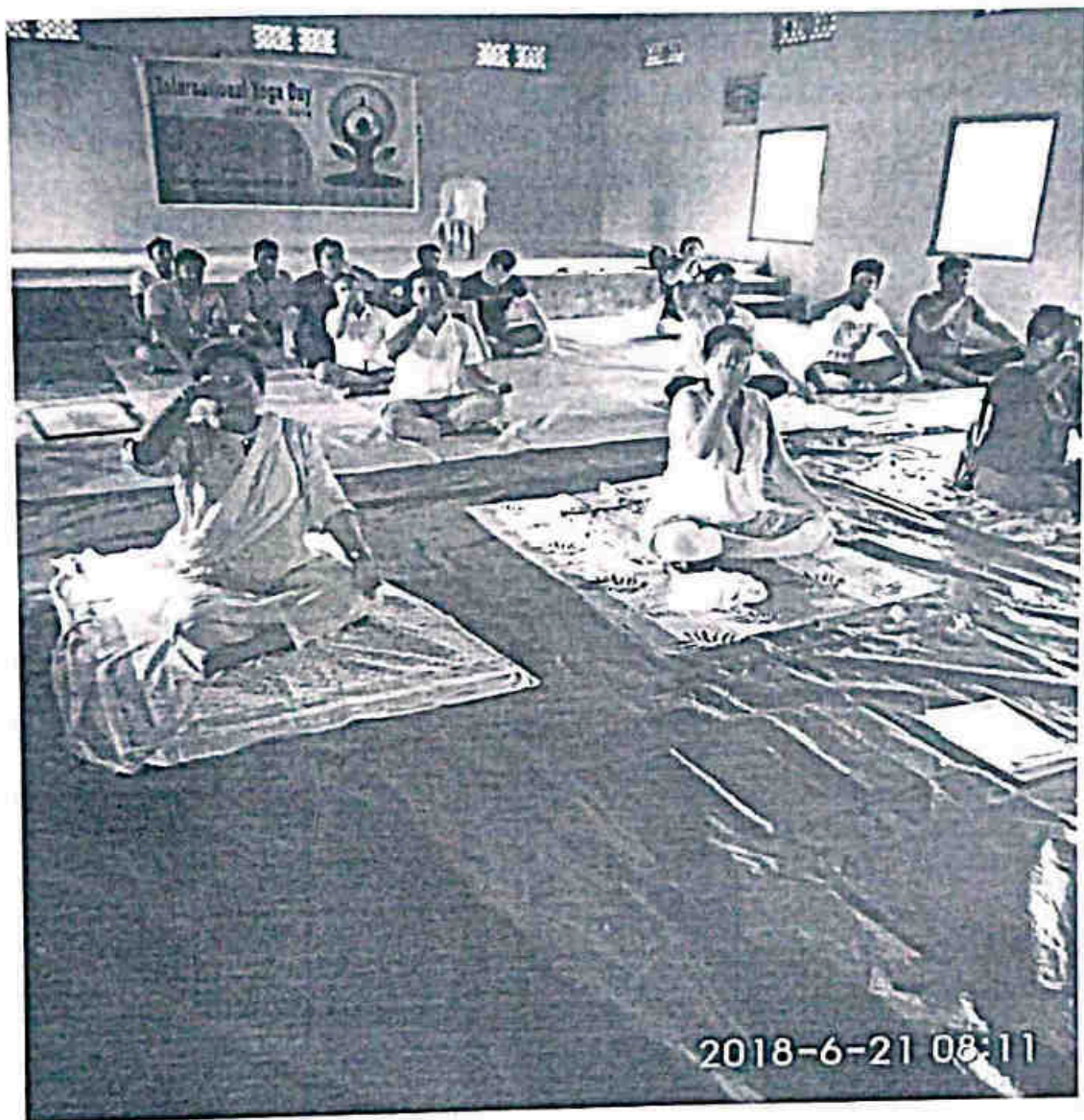

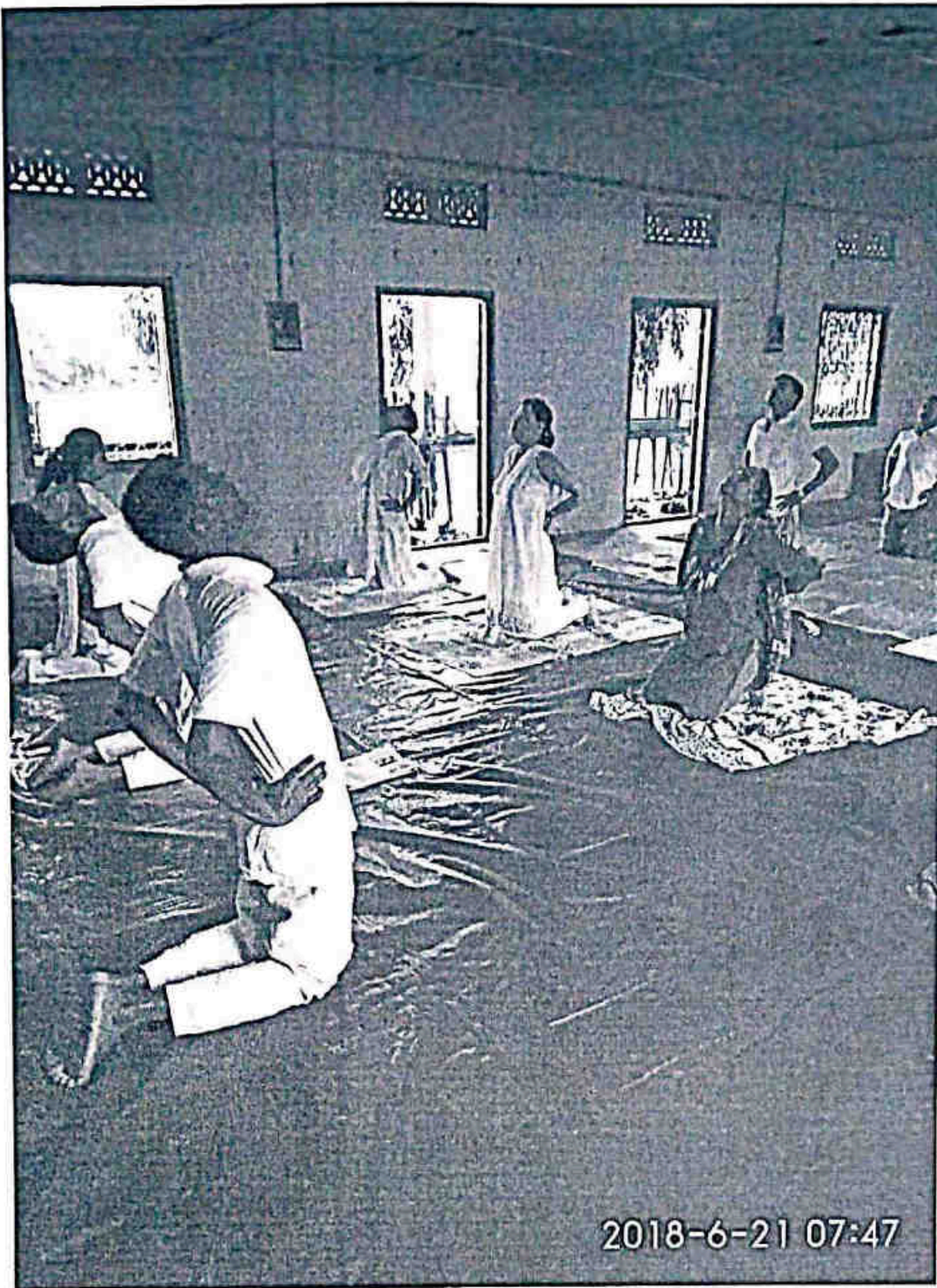


Report on International Yoga Day

Dated 16th August, 2018

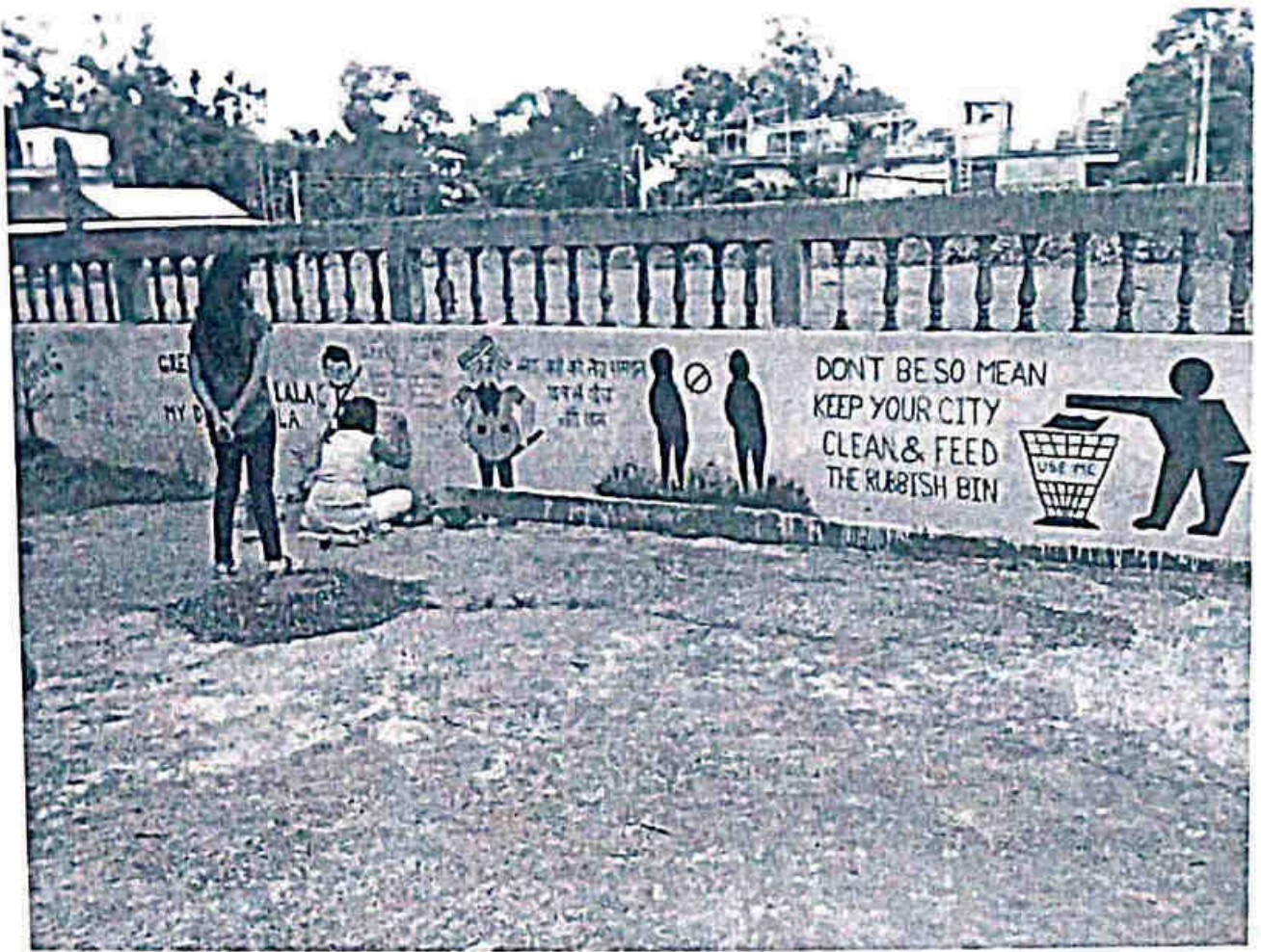

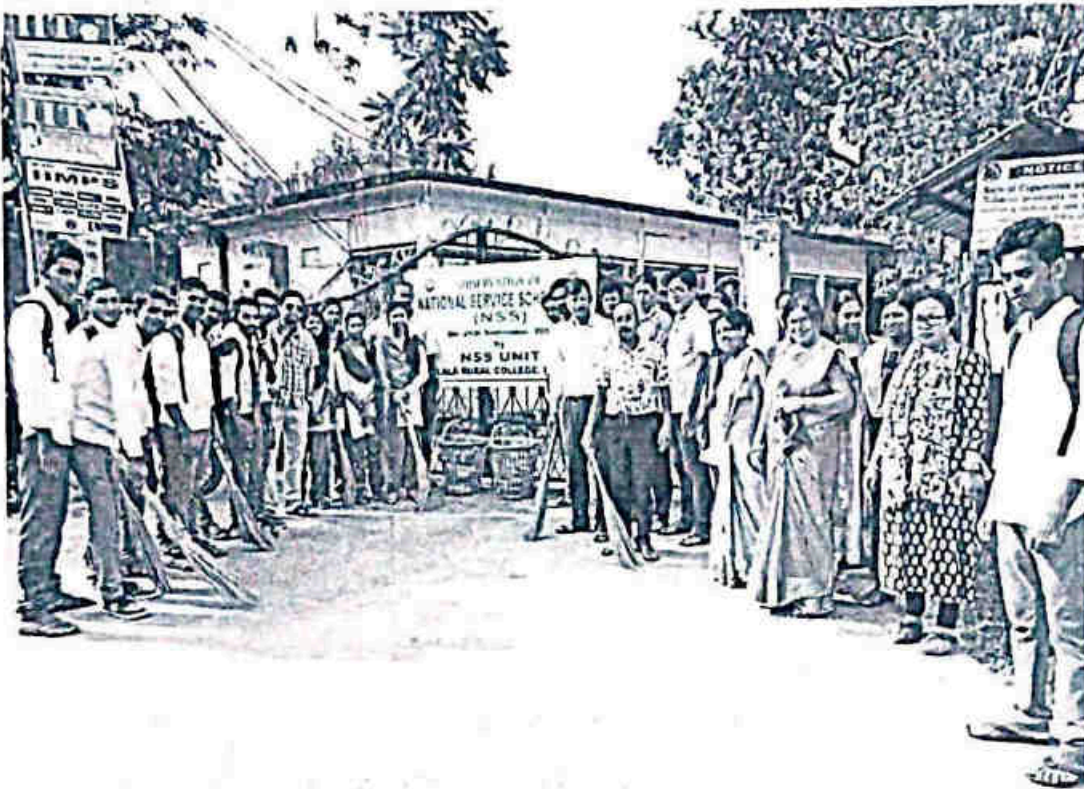
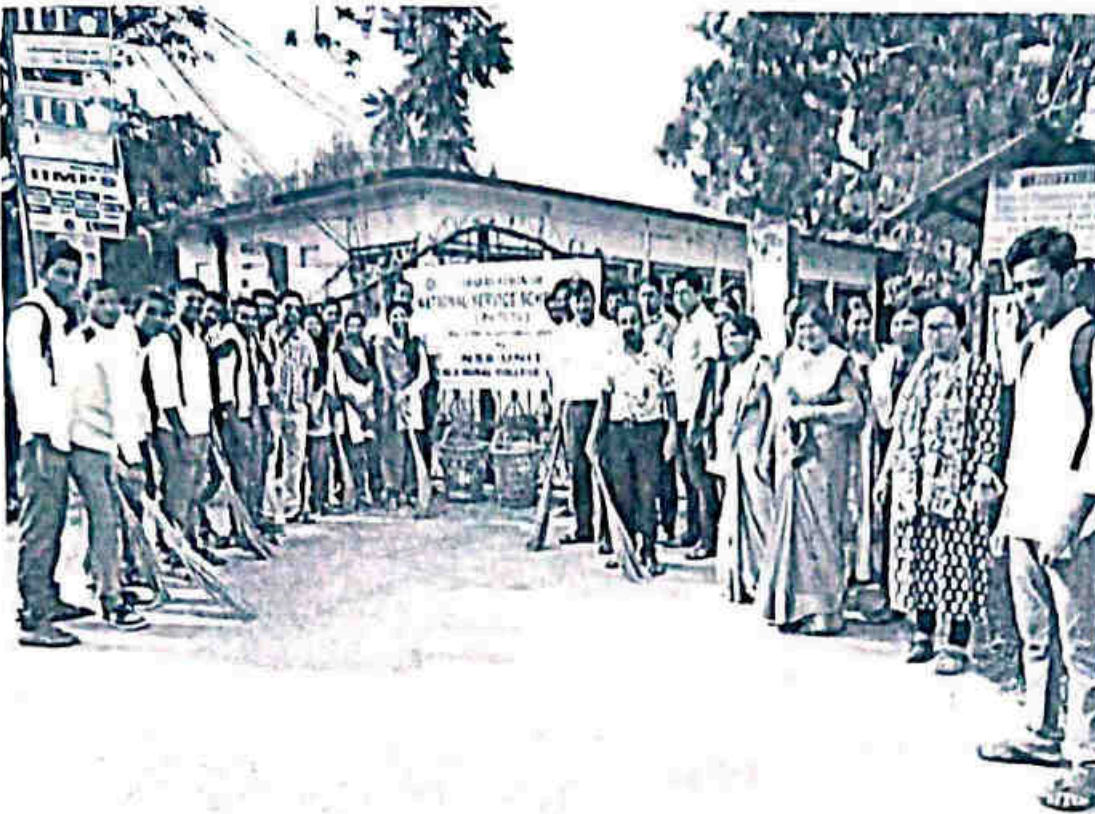

Report of Candlelight Vigil on 21/02/ 2019 as a mark of protest against Pulwama incident in Kashmir

Like the rest of India, this small town, Lala was shocked to the core due to the inhuman killing of several CRPF personnel by a terrorist attack at Pulwama, a city under the union territory of Jammu and Kashmir occurred on 14 February, 2019. On 21/02/ 2019 Lala Rural College organized under the aegis of IQAC in collaboration of NSS unit a silent candlelight vigil on the main thoroughfares of Lala town. After obtaining the due permission from the district authority the college faculty members, non-teaching staffs along with a good number of students joined together and started the solemn march towards the heart of the town at 6:00 p.m. starting from the college campus in order to pay homage to the martyrs as well as a mark of protest against the inhuman act of terrorism. It covered prominent streets of the town and came back to the college campus. Finally it ended with the lighting of candles on the Martyrs' altar in the college campus. The mood of the vigil was somber reflecting the trauma and pain due to the unprecedented terrorist attack on the unarmed CRPF personal at Pulwama.



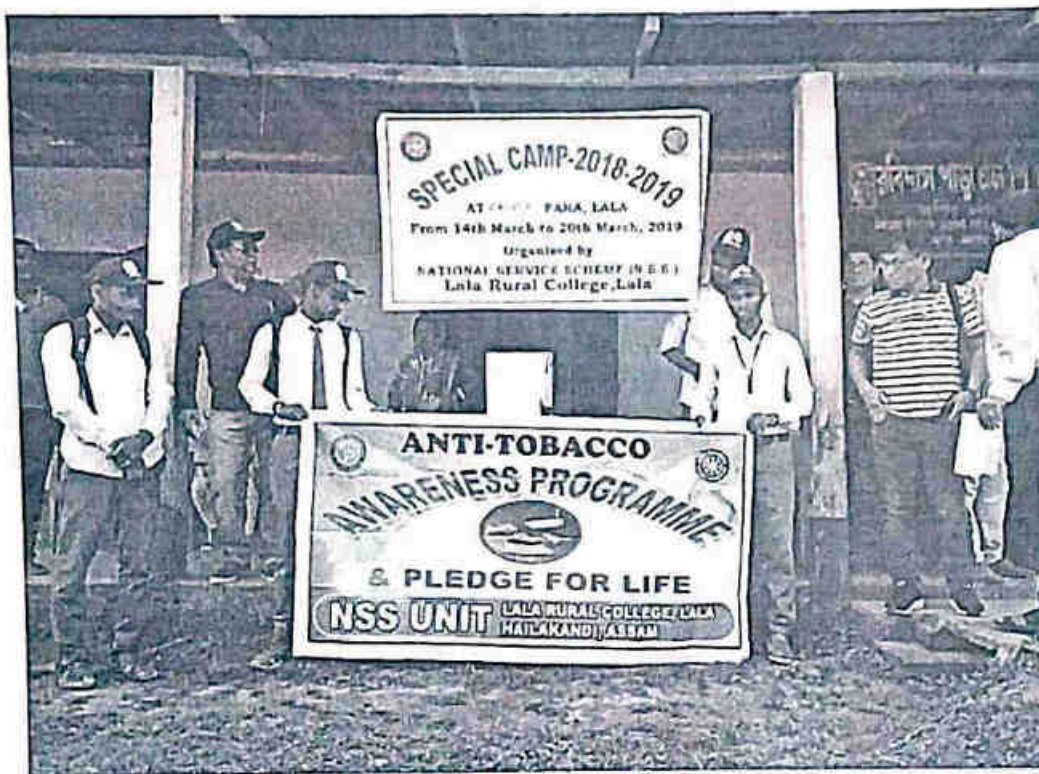

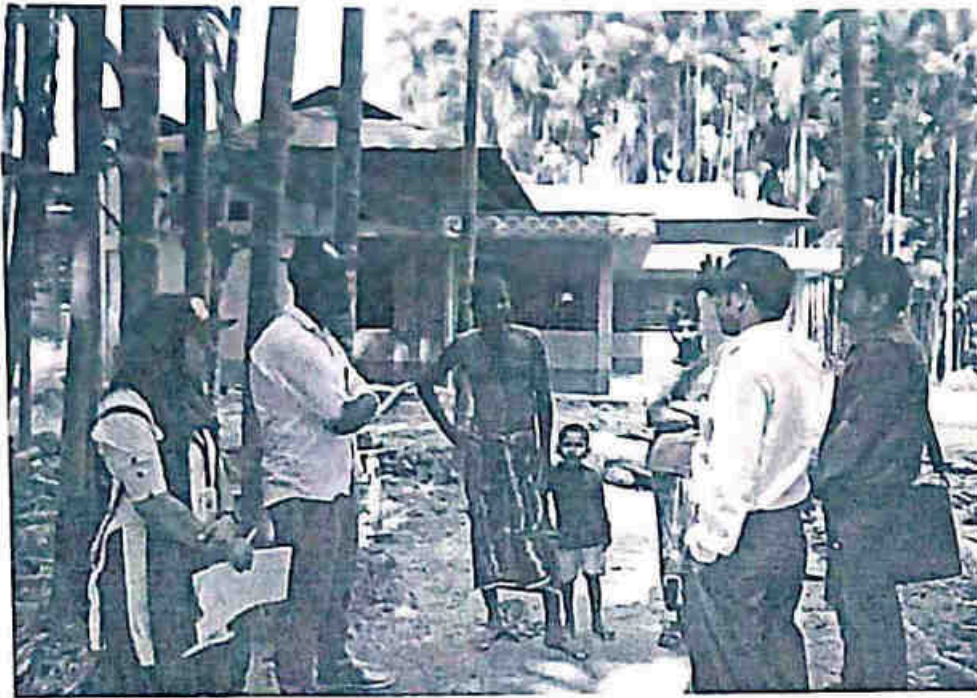

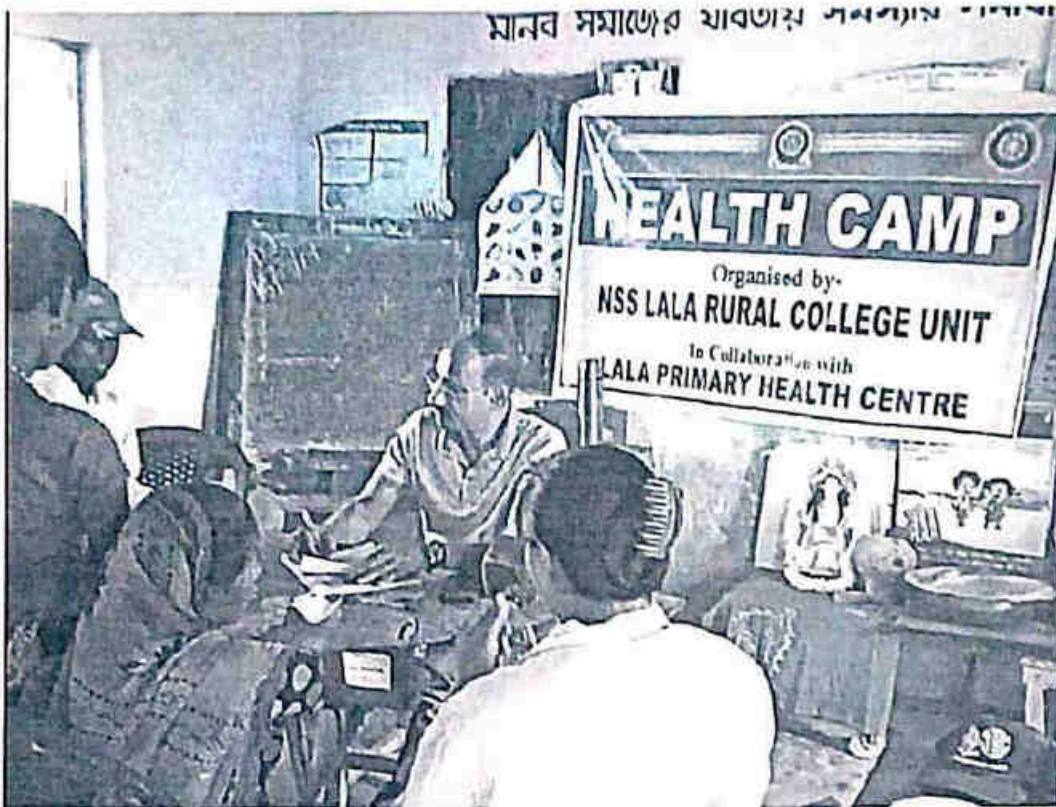
Report on Special Camp
Dated 21/03/2019

The NSS Unit of Lala Rural College, Lala organised a seven-day Special Camp at Rabidas Para on 14th March 2019. As the locality was on the outskirts of Lala and housed economically and socially weaker communities, the unit decided to orchestrate the special camp there. The camp was centred at Rabidas Para L.P. School and inaugurated by Mr. Tapan Nath, the Ward Commissioner in presence of the Principal of the college, Dr Tanuj Kumar Dey, Mrs. Abha Devi, teacher of the school along with the President, the pupils and other stakeholders of the school, local people, the current and the former Programme Officers, teacher members and as many as fifty volunteers of the unit. The theme of the camp was 'Health is Wealth' keeping in correspondence with the NSS theme of 'Healthy Youth for Healthy India'. 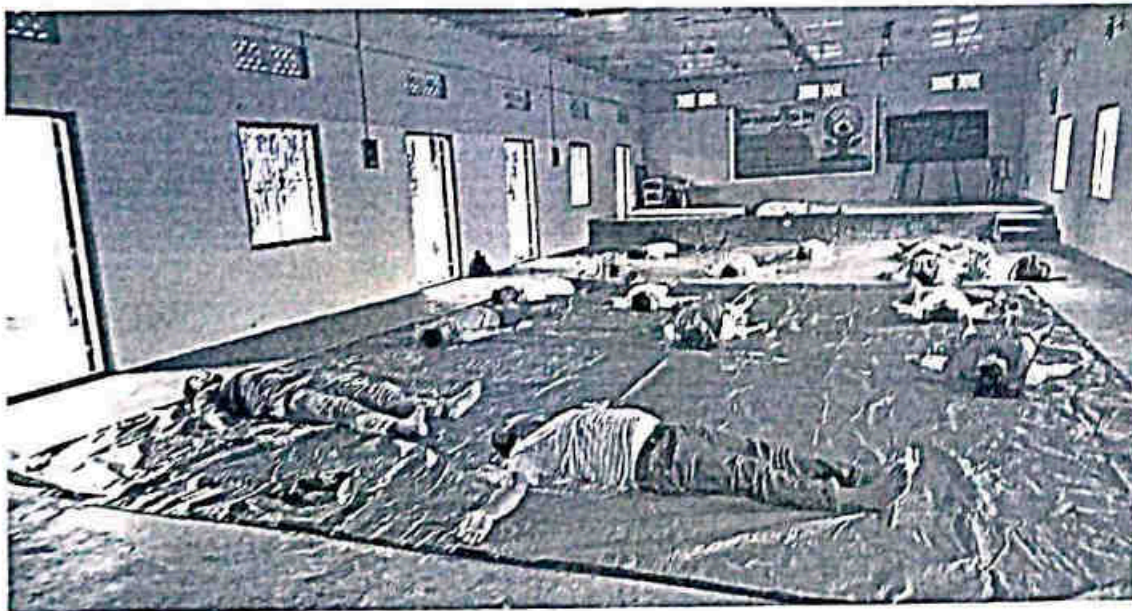

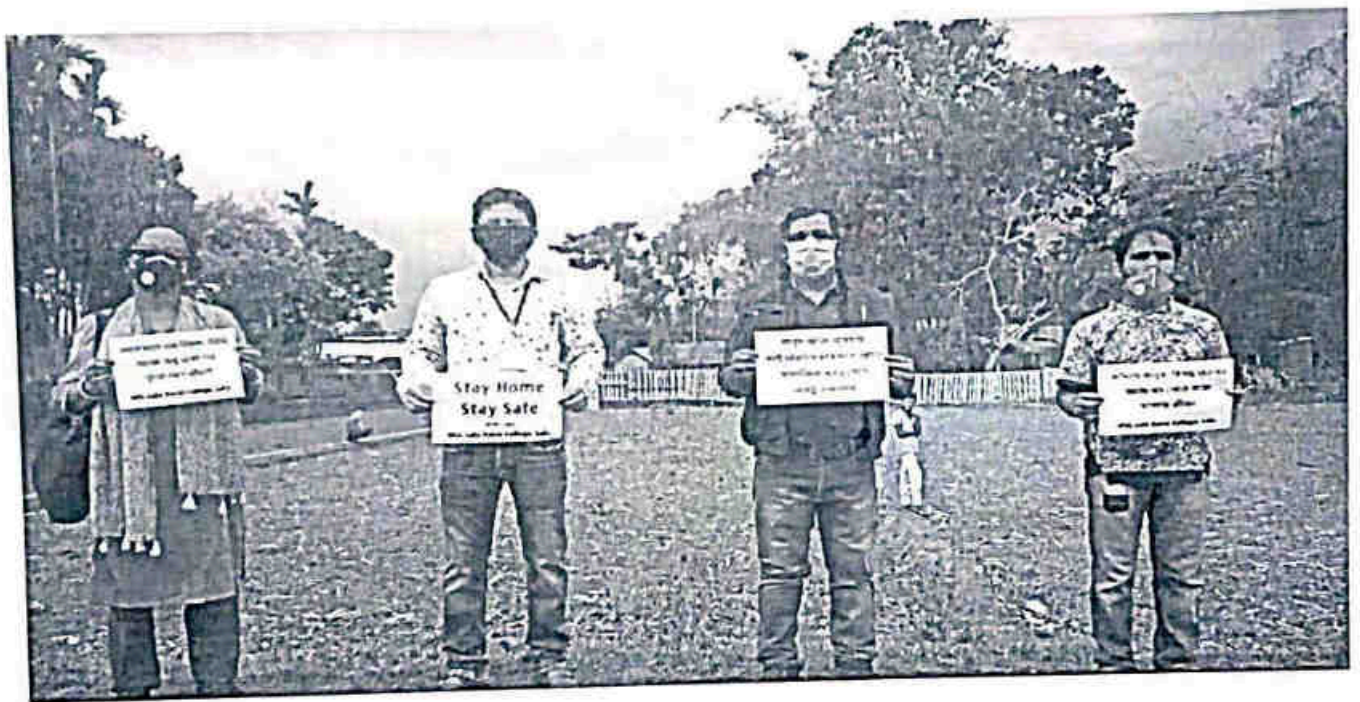
Report on Relief Work during COVID pandemic

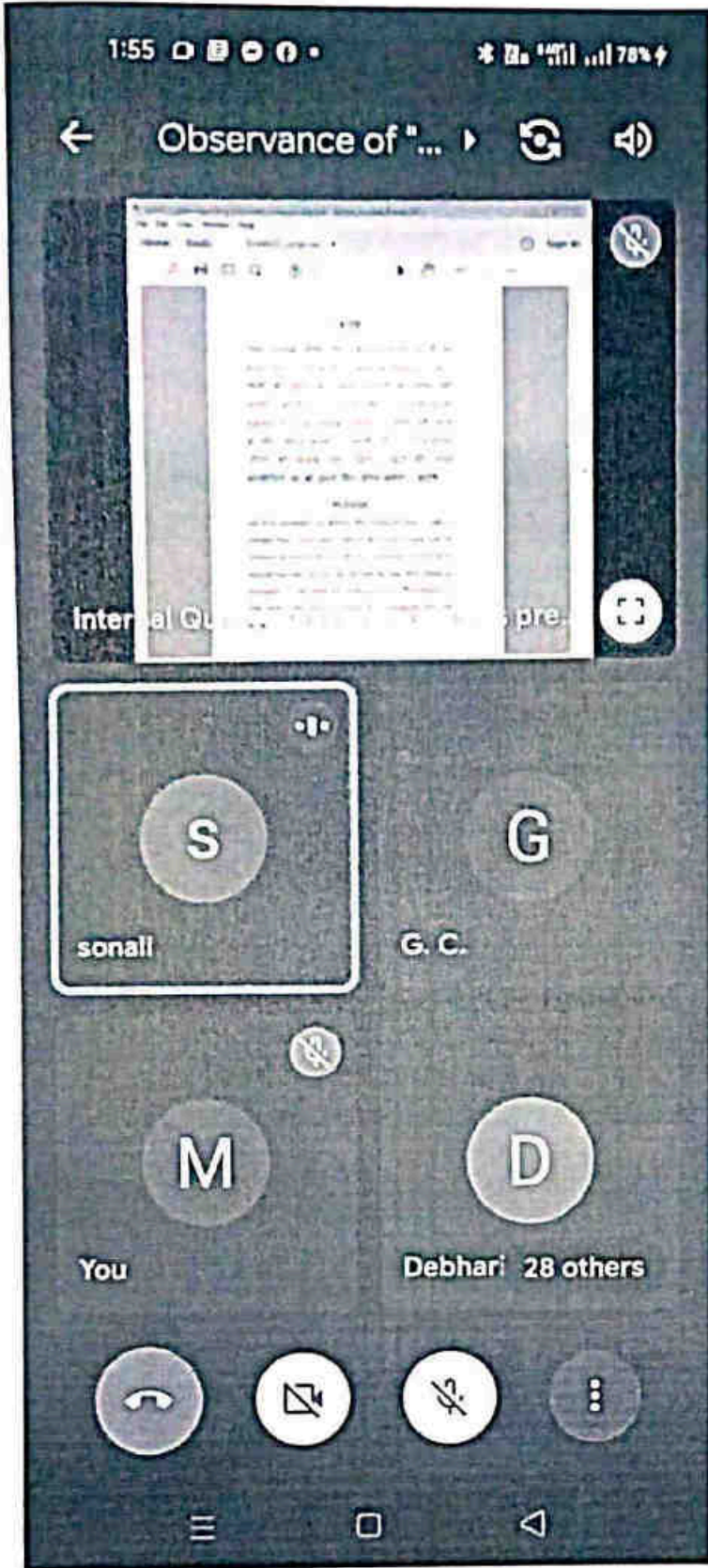
Report on World No Tobacco Day

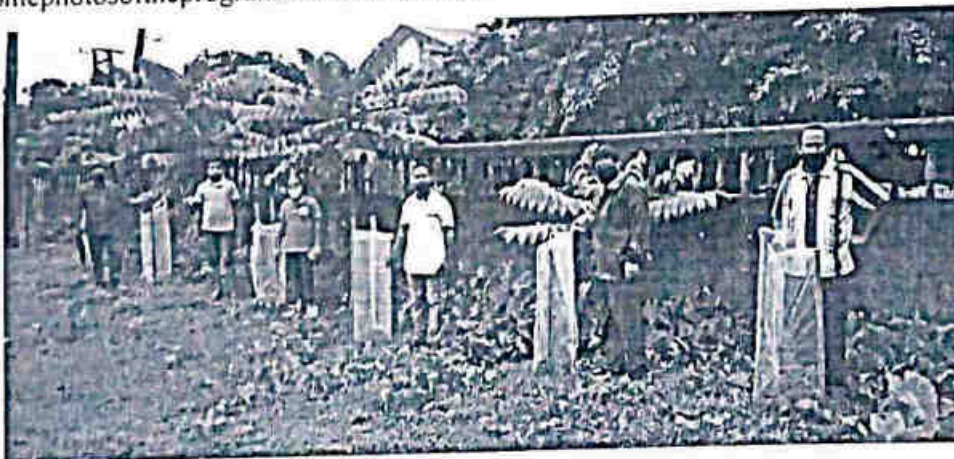

The event aimed at generating awareness of blood donation, especially at scrapping of replacement blood therapy amongst family members and familiar circles, which do not take notice of any health issues and complications of blood donors. It was a judicious combination of educational programme on the importance of blood donation through deliberation of speeches made by medical experts as well as the faculties and students of the college and cultural programme in the form of songs and dances. She initiated the programme by highlighting the importance of blood donation and its impact on the society. or virus by the donor to the recipient. She made an emphasis in her speech to evade the replacement therapy of blood donation and opt for the blood bank to make itself self-sufficient to meet the need of blood for the needy patients. Then another guest, Sanjoy Prakash Das, an "A" grade Tabla player and a Staff Artist, All India Radio, Silchar with her daughter, Jnanashree Das playing a harmonium presented a splendid display of a tabla-harmonium *jugalbandi* enthralling all viewers. The last speaker of the evening was Dr. Rajiv Biswas, Assistant Professor, Blood Bank, Silchar Medical College & Hospital, Silchar who actively coordinated the program from the Blood Bank. 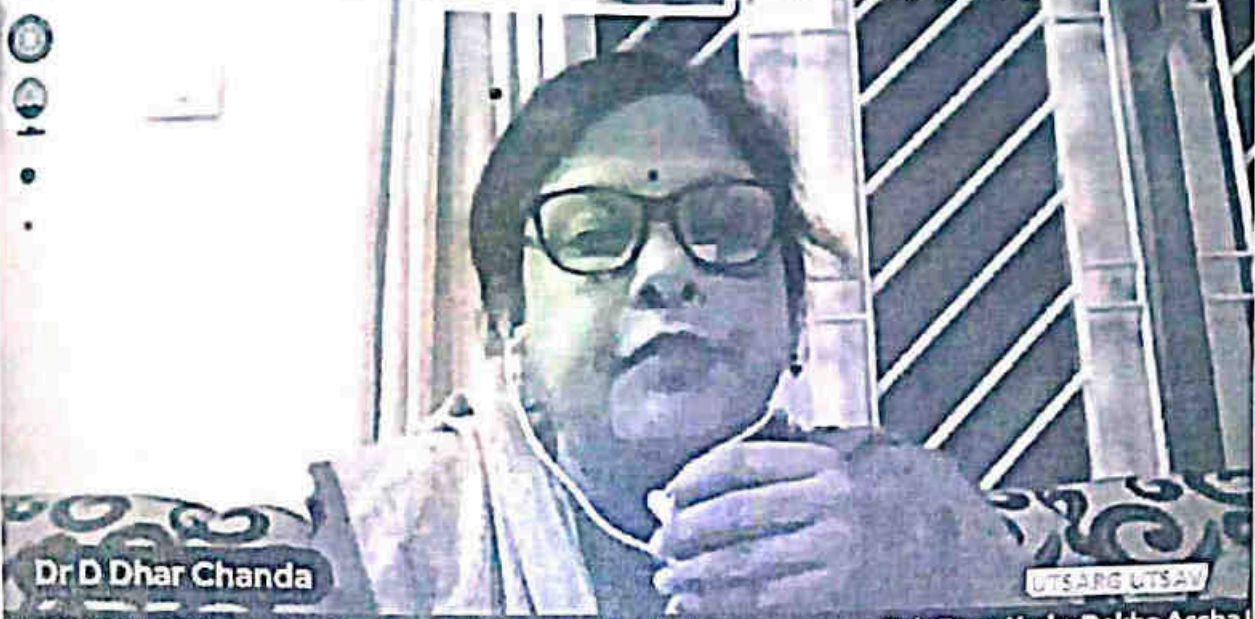

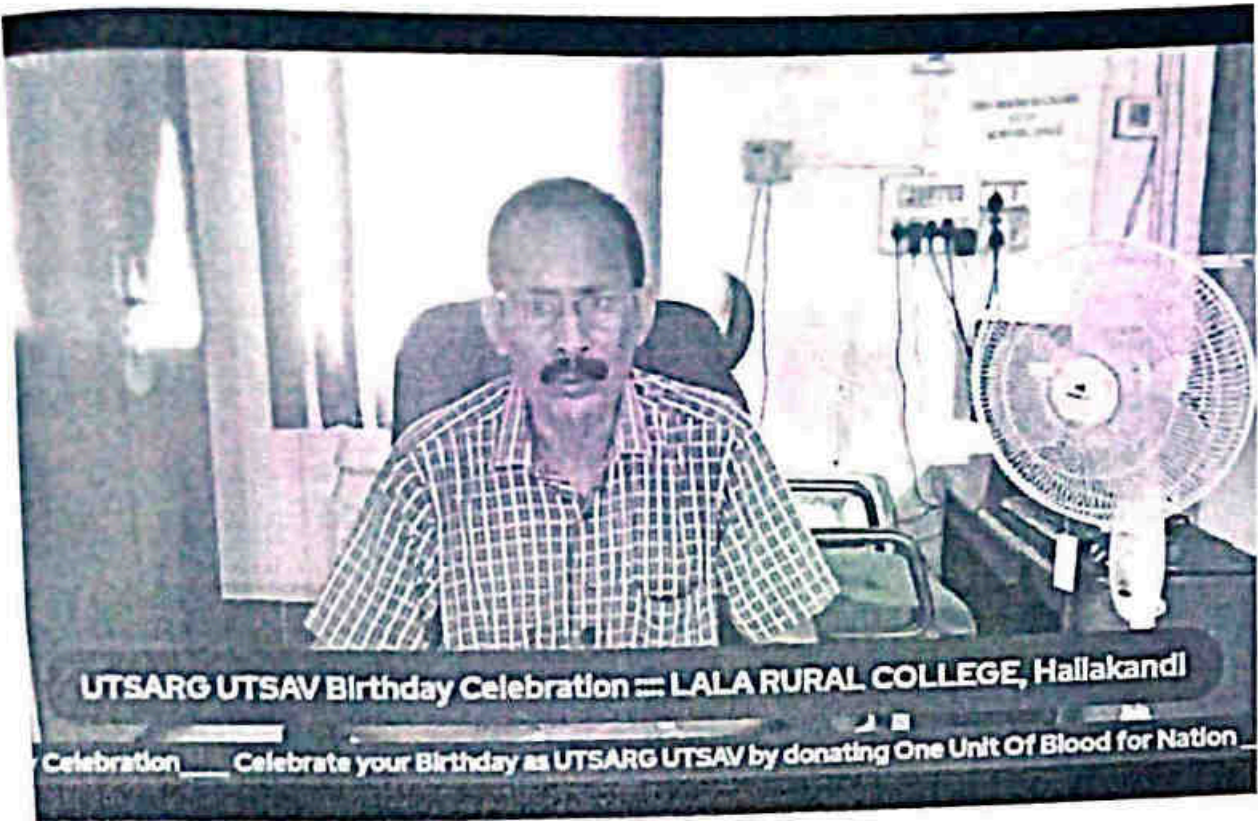

Report on the Awareness Programme about HIV, TB & Blood Donation

Dated 08/09/2021

NSS unit, Lala Rural College, Lala, in its bid to commemorate 75 years of India's Independence, organized the online competition among students of the college on three themes, namely HIV, TB & Blood Donation. The competition was designed to generate awareness campaign for New India@75 as formulated by ASACS under the guidance of NACO (National AIDS Control Organization). As per the guideline, the competition was supposed to be held from August 12-August 20, 2021. But due to the ongoing admission process of TDC Ist Semester (CBCS) and the submission process of assignments by students of Non CBCS coupled with the holding of Unit tests for CBCS Even Semester, the event in the form of the competition commenced from 22 August that lasted till 27 August. Report on Special Camp

Dated 15/03/2022

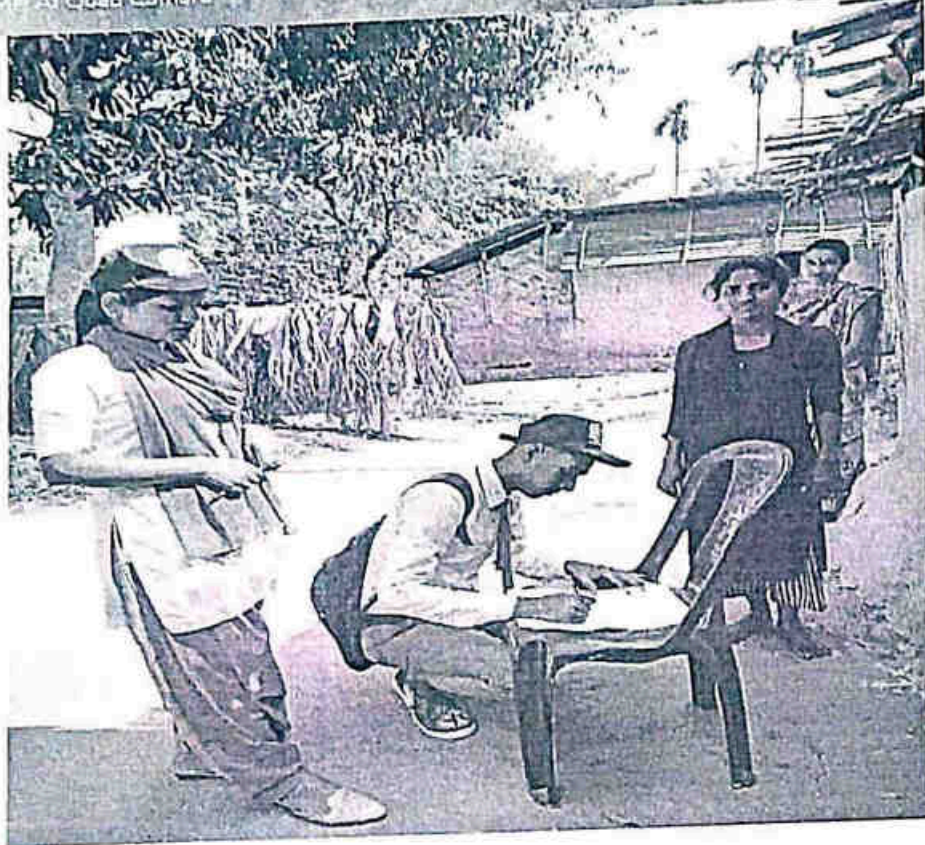
The NSS Unit of Lala Rural College organised a seven-day Special Camp at Singalla Basti on 9th March 2022. As the locality was on the outskirts of the town of Lala and inhabited by needy communities, the unit set up the special camp there. The camp was centred at Ayodhya Rai Memorial High School located at the rural background of Singalla Basti. In the inaugural address, Dr. Manas Sinha, Programme Officer of the unit, conveyed the aim and purpose of the camp. He said that the camp was designed to instil the idea of social welfare in volunteers and to provide services to the society, especially here to the under-privileged locality of Singalla Basti and to identify the needs and problems of the local community. Then Mr. Rupnarayan Roy, President of the school assured the unit of the full cooperation and assistance to the desired effect. Before that, Dr. Tanuj Kumar Dey, Principal of the college flagged off the camp. The theme of the camp was 'Youth for holistic development'. On the first day of the camp, the student-volunteers conducted with the aid of questionnaires a survey of the socio-economic conditions of people residing at Singalla Basti. In the process, the volunteers made door-to-door visits to households of the locality. The other noteworthy activities done throughout the week-long camp were Health camp, Plantation, Cleanliness Drive and Anti-Tobacco Awareness programme. The Health Camp was arranged in collaboration with Lala Primary Health Centre headed by Dr. Jahidul Islam and Dr. Mangan Sana Senjam. As many as 92 people were administered free medical check-up and provided free medicines. Then an awareness program was held on the issue of the ill-effects of tobacco consumption. The volunteers conducted a first-hand survey on the issue by paying visits to households of the locality and incorporated data in specific questionnaires. Thereafter, the importance of an eco-friendly environment was highlighted and the need of plantation was emphasized. To this effect, some hundred saplings were distributed to households and volunteers themselves planted the saplings along with the local people. The camp drew special attention to issues related to education, health, plantation and the like. The camp ended on 15th March with a pledge of rendering voluntary community services in the coming days.

and 3rd place respectively.

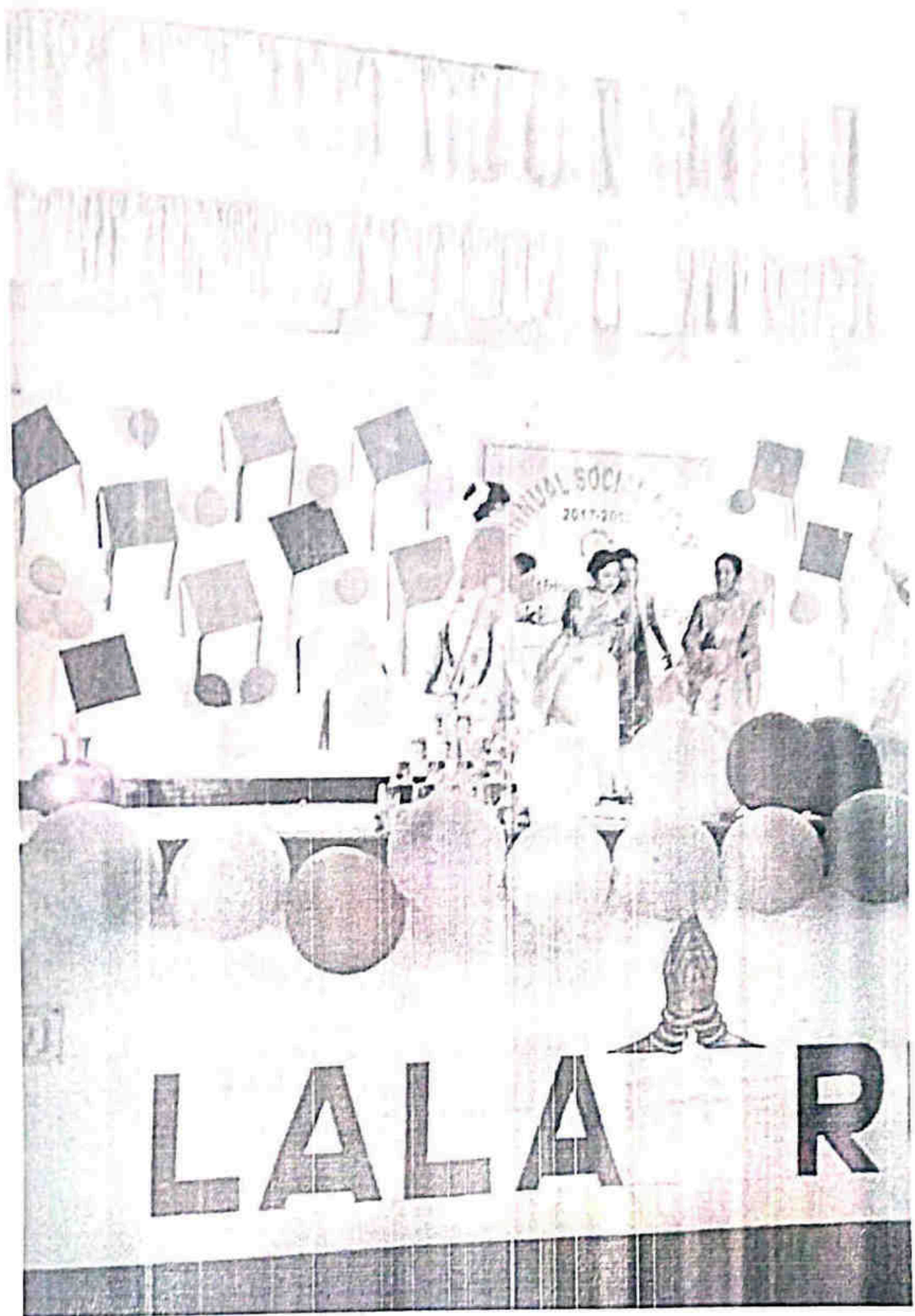
The 4th April from 11am to 1.30pm the annual festival was held which was followed by a

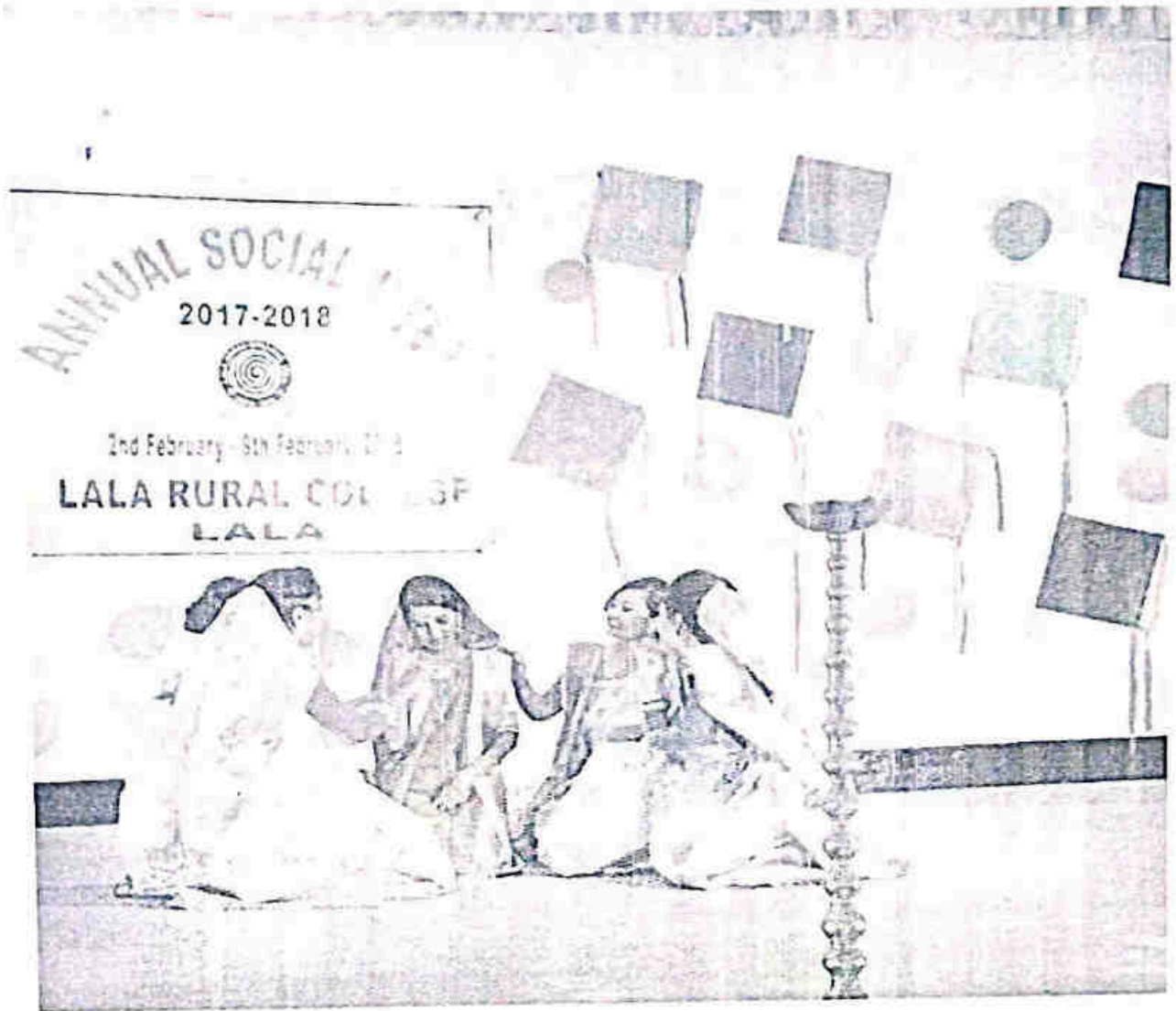

3. Monisha Nath, 3rd



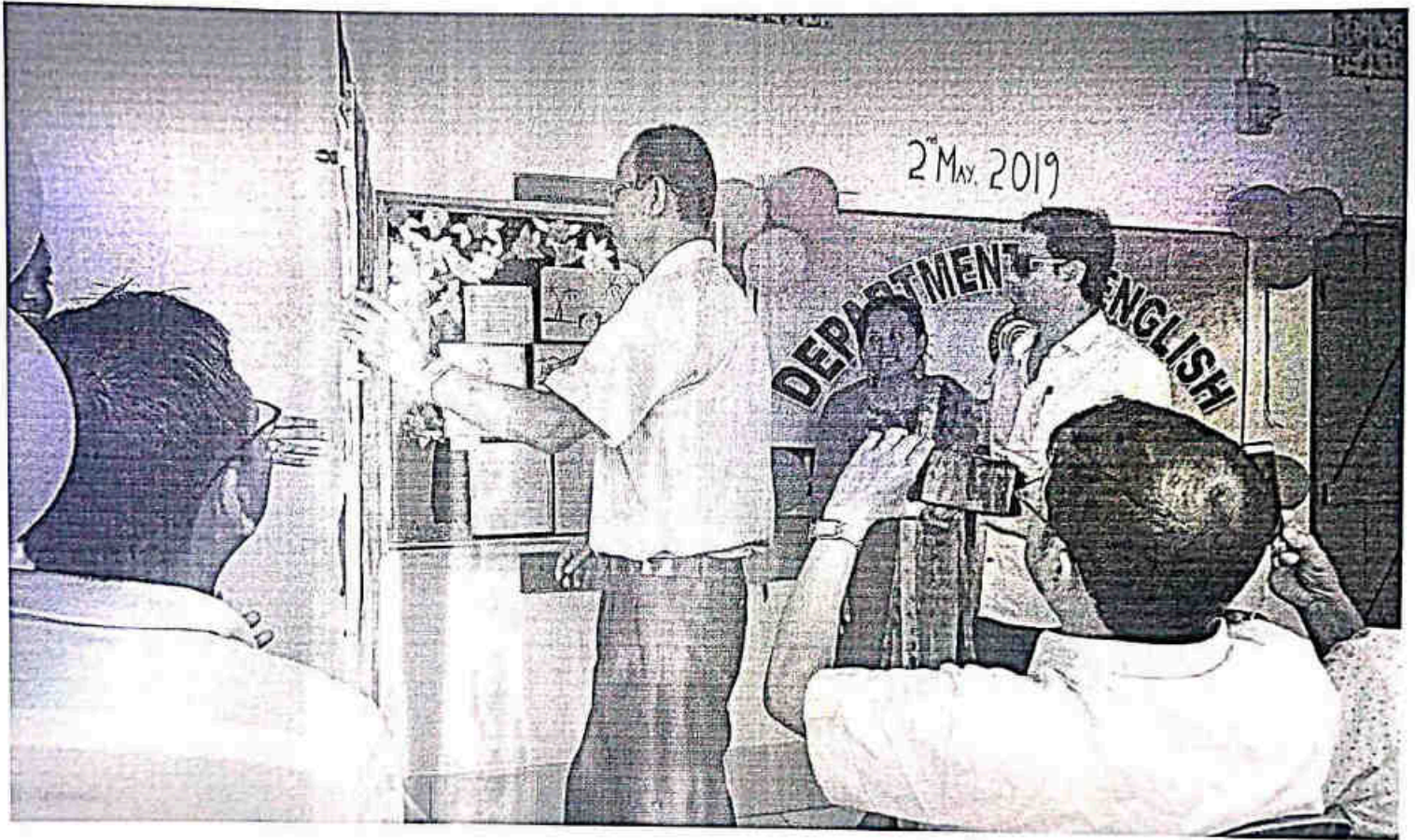
Report on Inauguration of Departmental Wall Magazine of English

Dayamoy Singha, HoD, Department of History. He emphasized on the significance of skill development and how necessary it is for every student to earn their livelihood independently.

The course was a meticulously designed tailoring course for beginners. Ms. Moonmoon Kangsabanik was hired as the instructor for the programme with arrangement of one stitching machine. The instructor was chosen based on her experience, qualification and her self-motivation to teach students. A total of 22 students, both from Arts and Commerce Stream, participated in the programme. In this course the basics of tailoring, which included how to take measurement, how to choose the right fabrics, and how to cut and sew a basic garment like blouse and kurti was taught. On the last day of the programme the students exhibited their skill of stitching, whatever they have learned from this vocational training programme and were also given participation certificates.

The valedictory session started from 2.30 p.m on 31st May, 2022 with the speech of Dr. Tanuj Kumar Dey, Principal i/c. The speech elucidated on the importance of imparting employability skills along with the process of holistic development of the students. The programme wrapped up around 4:30 p.m. with the vote of thanks from the Convenor. The college authority had given tremendous support and co-ordination in making this event successful.
