## Students' Satisfaction Survey Report

In the academic session 2020-21, a group of 165 students, selected randomly, were asked to fill up a Students Satisfaction Survey form comprising of few questions and statements on teaching- learning and evaluation, infrastructure and administration. The students participating in this survey were administered the Questionnaire ${ }^{\text {(Annexure-I) }}$ to submit responses within the given time frame i.e. from $27^{\text {th }}$ January, 2021 to $6^{\text {th }}$ February, 2021. The responses received from the students were analysed and interpreted as follows:

## Part I:-Teaching- Learning and Evaluation:

1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

## Recommendations on Teaching-Learning and Evaluation:

1. The teachers need to use modernised TLM more frequently to cater the needs of the students and also tomake classroom interaction more effective.
2. To pay attention to academically slow learners, it is recommended that every week class test may be taken. It will enhance learning process of the students.
3. The teachers need to apply student centric methods such as experimental learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for effective participation of the students.

## Recommendations on College Infrastructure:

1. Drinking water facility and toilet facility need to be improved.
2. Attention needs to be paid to boys and girls common room.
3. The students need to be encouraged in sports and more avenues are to be provided for more participation of the students.
4. The college library is an integral part of institutional education. From the response of the survey it is found that attention needs to be paid towards library. Following are the areas which need to be marked:
i. More reference books.
ii. Subscription of more journals and newspapers (national and state level).
iii. Full time zerox facility.

## Recommendations on College Administration:

1. The office staff needs to be more co-operative with the students.
